The Huron County General Health District Household Sewage Treatment Rules are a modification of there rescinded 2007 Ohio Department of Health rules. The Health District is providing this information packet to assist property owners with a process to follow to get a permit to install a sewage treatment system.

The Huron County General Health District only reviews the site, soil, and treatment system design information. This information must be presented for review and approved before a permit to install a sewage system can be issued. There are private companies & certified soil scientists that can provide the services needed in order for you to present the necessary information needed for our review.

The following attachments show you what information is needed in order to obtain a permit to install a system and where you can contract for these services.

- Check list for site and soil evaluation requirements
- List of Ohio soil scientists that can evaluate soil, and site conditions, and private companies that will design household sewage treatment systems
- An application for the Huron County General Health District to review the site, soil, and treatment system design information. *Note: A review of the information submitted **may** take up to three (3) weeks to complete*

NOTE: Prior to splitting any parcel of land, no matter the size, the Health District **strongly recommends** contacting the Huron County Soil & Water Conservation District at 419-668-4113 ext. 3 or the Huron County Tax Map Office at 419-668-2021 regarding Regional Planning requirements. *The Regional Planning requirements must be met in order for you to record the land parcel and receive a mailing address for the property.*

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CHECK LIST FOR SITE AND SOIL EVALUATION

This is a basic checklist of items ***needed before*** a site review application is completed. This information allows the Huron County General Health District to determine if the property meets the requirements for a sewage treatment system.

- _____ Site drawing no larger than 11" X 17" to scale (1"= 50', 1"= 40', 1"= 30') and showing lot dimensions and all the soil boring or excavation locations.
- _____ North orientation arrow
- _____ Existing or proposed dwellings and / or structures (i.e. barn, shed, workshop...)
- _____ Existing or proposed site disturbances (i.e. ponds, swimming pool, pasture, driveways or other hardscapes ...)
- _____ Location of all existing or proposed private water systems and surface water features on the lot or within fifty (50) feet of the lot lines
- _____ Location of any easements or right of ways on the lot
- _____ Designated wetlands or 100 year flood plains on the lot
- _____ At least two (2) locations with adequate contour lengths are indicated where a sewage treatment system is possible

SITE AND SOIL CHARACTERISTICS

- _____ The property owner must hire a certified soil scientist to conduct a site and soil analysis of the property
- _____ Submit a properly completed Ohio Department of Health Site and Soil Evaluation for Treatment and Dispersal form for **each soil boring / excavation location**
- _____ Provide site descriptions to include: slope, vegetation, drainage features, rock outcrops, erosion and other natural features
- _____ Document any geological, surface and / or ground water risks for potential contamination on the lot or surrounding area
- _____ Designate any areas or conditions that prohibit a sewage treatment system

DESIGN PLAN OR LAYOUT

- _____ A household sewage treatment system design plan or a layout must be provided.
It is recommended that you work closely with your system designer in order to explore all available system options before deciding on the design that is submitted for review.
