

H1N1 FLU SHOT CLINICS

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Ohio Department of Health and Huron County General Health District still recommends that those who have not yet received an H1N1 flu shot get one. Groups most at risk for H1N1 flu complications include pregnant women, those under age 25, and those with asthma, diabetes, underlying heart, lung or kidney problems, or a suppressed immune system.
