VACCINES FOR TEENS

Vaccines can help keep teens healthy now & as they grow older & prevent the spread of disease to others. Schedule an appointment today with your doctor to have your teen vaccinated. VACCINES PROTECT TEENS FROM:

- **WHOOPING COUGH (Pertussis)**-This disease is spread by coughing and sneezing. Anyone can catch Pertussis and spread it to others. Teens may be sick for weeks and spread it to others that may die from the disease.

- **MENINGITIS**-Teens are at an increased risk for this bacterial infection. Meningitis can kill a healthy person in less than 48 hours. Survivors can have serious problems that last the rest of their lives.

- **HPV (Human Papillomavirus)**-HPV disease is the leading cause of cervical cancer in women. Now available for both girls and boys.
