Influenza (flu) (a respiratory virus (not the stomach flu); ≥ 2 of these: fever of $\geq 100^\circ\text{F}$, cough, runny nose, nasal congestion, sore throat; sometimes also diarrhea, nausea and vomiting but do not count gastrointestinal symptoms in the minimum 2 symptom criteria; do not count absences that were diagnosed as something else, e.g. strep throat or a cold)						
Gastrointestinal Illness (stomach "flu") (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal cramps)						
Common Cold (cough, fever, fatigue with no other known diagnosis)						
Chickenpox (red or swollen spots that turn into pimplelike blisters filled with clear or cloudy fluid, fever $\geq 100.3^\circ\text{F}$, headache, sore throat, little or no appetite, felling sick/tired/sluggish)						
Other Communicable Illness (includes illnesses that can be spread, e.g. pink eye, strep and mono)						
Non-Communicable Illness (illness that would not be contagious, e.g. migraine and allergies)						
Unknown Illness (guardian indicates child is ill but provides no information)						

Please report physician diagnosed cases of pertussis (whooping cough), drug resistant staph infection, measles, mumps, meningitis, and cases of flu-like illness in a student who has traveled to an affected area in the past 10 days or has had contact with a confirmed or suspect case in the past 7 days.
