

# Employee Illness Log

Reportable disease for food service workers: Campylobacter, Cryptosporidium, Cyclospora, Entamoeba histolytica, E.coli 0157:H7 and Shiga toxin-producing E. coli, Giardia, Hepatitis A, Norovirus, Salmonella spp., Salmonella Typhi, Shigella spp., Vibrio cholera, Yersinia. Employees should not work with any of these illnesses.

If employees are having diarrhea, vomiting, jaundice, or fever, they should be excluded from work. Be aware of your company's illness policy.

Managers or persons in charge should keep track of when workers are sick, and whether they were excluded or restricted from work.
