Grant Updates:

The Ohio Department of Health (ODH)'s Youth Suicide Prevention (YS) Grant:

- The selected "Tier 1" activity is reducing access to lethal means. Goodwill Industries and the Enrichment Center of Huron County are new partners for tier 1. Currently working on partnerships with Family & Children First Council and Mercy Health Willard.
- The selected "Tier 2" activity is Counseling on Access to Lethal Means (CALM) training. Huron County Public Health continues to look for new partners.
- The selected "Tier 3" activity is the SOS (Signs of Suicide) Program. Willard implemented SOS before Thanksgiving break. Sue Wilson shared that MRSS was called out to FTMC emergency department to do assessments as a result of the program being implemented. HCPH will update MOU for Tier 3 to include the schools must give MRSS a heads up that the program will be implemented to properly prepare and provide the students with free assessments as the assessments done at FTMC will be billed to the parents.

Strategic Prevention Framework (SPF) Grant:

- The Youth Summit will be on March 3, 2026 at Grace church in Fremont from 9am-1:30pm
 - o Theme: Lead the Change

The Drug Free Communities (DFC) Grant:
