MEETING MINUTES

The Huron County Creating Healthy Communities Committee met on Wednesday, June 14, 2023, inperson for the 2023 Quarter 2 Meeting. Kayla Johnson began the meeting at 9:33 AM. Kayla welcomed the committee members, started with introductions, twelve (12) total members were in attendance.



CHC REVIEW:

Kayla provided an overview of the CHC Grant updates including the FY24 grant application. Huron County Public Health (HCPH) is one of 23 counties that has been awarded the CHC grant. The CHC grant operates on a 5-year grant cycle (2020-2024), typically awarding \$105,000.00 per year to implement active living and healthy eating strategies in the three priority communities (Norwalk, Willard, and All Huron County). We are now in our fourth grant year cycle.

Kayla reviewed the current list of coalition members. The coalition is always in need of project volunteers, project sponsors and champions.

UPDATES:

The end of the second quarter is nearing (June 30, 2023) and quarter two report is due on July 10, 2023. There is no June newsletter as there was a coalition meeting. In addition, members were asked to assist in establishing a game plan for the final grant period of the 5-year grant cycle ending in 2024.

GUEST SPEAKER:

Catherine Mavrich, LCPH CHC Coordinator presented "Pocket Parks". Ms. Machrich explained what a pocket park was and the need for creating these small-scale spaces. Members were given an opportunity to partake in a brief Q/A at the end of the presentation.

Request for 2024 Project Ideas:

For the 2024 grant year, Huron County CHC was approached with three (3) possible projects that need to be completed throughout the county. Listed below are the possible projects and their subsequent details (3)

Greenwich Reservoir Park 2 (NEW PARK) - Greenwich



- CHC was asked to sponsor a portion of the cost for a new park to be installed on North Side of Park
 - Small playground structure
 - Surface material
 - Protective Net
- Will provide safe play area for children on the North Side of Park
- Cost of the sponsorship would be \$14,500+

Norwalk Memorial Reservoir Park - Norwalk

- CHC was asked to sponsor the cost for asphalt for walking path
- Current asphalt path is no longer safe and remains a hazard
- Cost of the sponsorship would be \$24,000

City Of Willard Park - Willard

- CHC was asked to sponsor the cost for one (1) all-inclusive playground equipment piece
- This would help reach the goal of completing the Kiddie Land renovation project
- Cost of the sponsorship would be \$10,000
