



RESOLUTION 2022-86
A resolution to approve the fee schedule for the
Implementation and Administration of the Campground Rules
October 6, 2022

The Board of Health of Huron County Public Health, Huron County, Ohio met at a regular meeting of the Board, on October 6th, 2022 at 1:00 p.m.; whereupon the following was placed in consideration on the regular agenda of the Board:

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of Huron County Public Health has completed a cost methodology in compliance with Chapters 3729.07 and 3709.09 of the Ohio Revised Code and 3701-36-14 of the Ohio Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of Huron County Public Health, to properly implement and administer 3701-26 of the Ohio Administrative Code, repeals the District portion of the fee schedule established in Resolution 2021-93; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the fees have subsequently been evaluated and voted upon after three public readings and a public hearing with the Board voting as indicated below. An electronic copy of Resolution 2022-86 will be maintained at the District's office for proper record keeping and reporting purposes.

Temporary - 50 sites or less (Event fee)	\$78.04
Temporary - more than 50 sites (Event fee plus additional fee per site >50)	\$1.12
