WILLARD, Ohio- The Creating Healthy Communities (CHC) program at Huron County Public Health (HCPH) is excited to announce the opening of Willard City Park's newly renovated section, Kiddie Land! Huron County CHC funds were used to purchase an inclusive playground spinner.

Although the project is not fully finished, Kiddie Land is ready to be safely opened to the public. Note that there will be periods of light construction in which certain areas may be closed off for the installation of tables, benches, and a new fence. Please avoid these areas during times of construction.

An official ribbon-cutting ceremony will take place next spring: please follow the City of Willard's social media page for more information to come.
