## 2023 Huron County Community Health Assessment Released

NORWALK, Ohio— The Huron County Health Partners' Steering Committee, comprised of the Huron County Board of Mental Health and Addiction Services (HCMHAS), Huron County Public Health (HCPH), Fisher-Titus Medical Center (FTMC), and Mercy Health – Willard Hospital (MWH) is excited to announce the official completion and release of the 2023 Huron County Community Health Assessment (CHA) – a collection of information on the health status, quality of life, social determinants of health, and risk factors impacting Huron County residents.

This county-wide health assessment has been compiled to create a current snapshot of the health of Huron County residents and is intended to help community stakeholders better understand the health needs and priorities of Huron County residents, to ultimately help direct community resources to where they will have the biggest impact. The Huron County Health Partners' Steering Committee hopes that the 2023 Huron County CHA serves as a guide to target and prioritize limited resources, a vehicle for strengthening community relationships, and a source of information that contributes to keeping people healthy.
