## Coalition Updates

The coalition continues to meet monthly at Huron County Public Health. The coalition was able to provide bracelets to most Huron County Schools for students to have during prom. These bracelets we branded with the sober positive messaging "Sober is the Vibe." The coalition will use prevention funding to purchase Find Your Anchor boxes for the schools in the county. Find Your Anchor (FYA) is a grassroots movement aimed at suicide prevention, awareness, and education. With creativity and a personal touch, FYA aims to support those who may be struggling and de-stigmatize conversations surrounding suicide and mental health. The boxes will be purchased this summer and distributed to schools at the beginning of the 26-27 school year. The coalition hosted Street Smart: Ohio training on April 14, 2026. This training provided current and up-to-date information on trends, terminology, paraphernalia, and physiological effects of drug use.

### School-Based Therapy

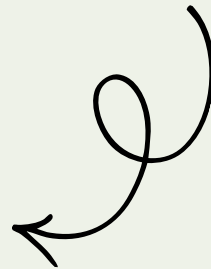
- It is outpatient mental health therapy and behavioral health counseling implemented in the school setting
