- Insurance Card
 - HCPH is an in-network provider for Medicaid, Medicare, and many private insurances.
- Parent/guardian ***must*** accompany any minors.
 - No child is turned away for Vaccines for Children (VFC) vaccines if their family is unable to pay for the shots.
 - For families covered by out of network private insurance, we can give you a receipt to turn into your insurance company.

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
