Huron County Hospitals, Laboratories, and Providers,

With October approaching, this signifies the start of the 2022 – 2023 flu season, the time when we typically start to see an increase in flu activity in Ohio. While flu cases can occur year-round, Huron County Public Health (HCPH) tracks and releases flu reports during flu season (weeks 40-20), which can be found here, <u>https://www.huroncohealth.com/influenza-surveillance</u>, on flu cases in the county. We rely on this information from the weekly Influenza-Like Illness Tracking Reporting completed by our hospitals, labs, and providers in the county to compile this report.

For those who have completed the flu surveillance reporting in previous years and have continued to do so even beyond flu season, thank you, and at this time, we ask that our hospitals, labs, and providers continue or begin the influenza-like illness and positive flu case reporting via our survey that is available on SurveyMonkey: <u>https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/9H33S8F</u>.
