The coalition continues to meet monthly to collaborate on prevention efforts in Huron County. We continue to grow, adding new members monthly. We are diligently working to assist in the expansion of prevention efforts among all 8 school districts in Huron County. In order to do so, we have been strengthening our relationships with Huron County schools by offering our support toward their prevention efforts for the upcoming prom and graduation seasons.

Firelands Hope Line

A message from Lauren Robinson at Firelands Counseling and Recovery Services:

"Hope Line has been able to operate solely through the support of local mental health and addiction boards. In recent years the Ohio Department of Behavioral Health (DBH) has redirected funding from Boards to 988. 988 is a suicide & crisis line that operates 24 hours per day, 365 days per year.

*Unfortunately, there is no longer sufficient funding to support both Hope Line and 988 services, therefore **Hope Line will cease operations at midnight on 3/21/26**. Effective 3.22.26 persons experiencing behavioral health crises will need to utilize 988 for support."*
